

Forex Hacked Version 2.0 Installation Guide

WARNING #1: Make sure you read about the settings and recommended account sizes before using this EA!

WARNING #2: Forex Hacked will work on one LIVE account at a time, and that is the account number you have inputed in your membership profile settings. You may use both versions on an unlimited number of demo accounts.

WARNING #3: If you choose to refund, please note that your copy of Forex Hacked will no longer work!

Before you can use Forex Hacked, you will need to input your forex account number if you have not already done so in your forexhacked.com account. Please visit

to login, and click the edit profile settings link shown below.



Then you will see a screen like shown below. Take note of your username, you will need to input it into the Forex Hacked EA parameters each time you attach it to a chart. At the bottom you will see an account number field. This will be your forex broker account number. So whatever account you want to run Forex Hacked on, you will need that account number updated in your profile. This can be changed at anytime, but you can only run 1 account at a time unless you buy multiple licenses.




Once you're done here, click save profile, then the back button and you're done this part. You will now need to open up your metatrader 4 terminal and start attaching Forex Hacked to your desired charts.

If you haven't done so already, copy and paste the ForexHacked.ex4 into your (C:\Program files\Metatrader 4\experts) folder. This path may differ depending on the letter of your drive you have metatrader 4 installed to, and the broker you downloaded metatrader from.


Once you have ForexHacked.ex4 in the right directory, you can load up your Metatrader 4 terminal, and you will see it in the Navigator window (Ctrl + N) under the Expert Advisors tree. You will want to click and drag and drop it onto a **USDJPY, GBPUSD, EURUSD, AUDUSD, USDCHF chart on the M30 or H1 timeframe only!**

IMPORTANT: USDJPY has been the best performing currency pair as of late, but check the members area to get an update on best performing currency pairs.




Do not worry about the icon beside it being grayed out. What this means is that you do not have the source code, which you don't need.

As soon as you drop it on the chart, you will see a box appear with two tabs at the top, inputs and common. On the common tab, make sure yours looks just like this below.




If you are running on a LIVE account, then before you press OK, go over to the Inputs tab and enter in your username at the top parameter shown below.

For DEMO accounts, you do NOT need to enter a username.



Make sure if you are running on an ECN broker, you have the ECN parameter set to TRUE and if not, set it to FALSE like below. Also make sure to change the **MagicNumber** to something unique for each chart you attach ForexHacked to.





Once your done here, hit OK!

If you checked the confirm DLL function calls, then you will have a bunch of popups like this confirming the connection to our server. This will only happen when connecting a LIVE account. If you didn't check Confirm DLL function calls, then these annoying popups won't show, but the connections will still be made.



If you see this on the top left of your chart, 1 of 3 things can be wrong

1. You entered the wrong username into the EA's parameters
2. You entered the wrong account number into your forex hacked profile
3. You didn't check mark the Allow DLL Calls.

Also make sure you have expert advisors enabled like this...



If successful, and everything checks out, your chart will look like this...
